TT EUROCUP OPEN TOURNAMENT

PARTNERS









1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.1 The TT EUROCUP OPEN tournament will take place on 24 August 2025 at the Radzymin Cultural and Sports Centre (ROKiS), located at Jana Pawła II Street 20, Radzymin.
- 1.2 The event is organized by Winners Sports Hub Polska sp. z o.o., in cooperation with the Mazovian Table Tennis Association (MZTS) and the Radzymin Cultural and Sports Centre.
- 1.3 The title sponsor of the tournament is Winners Sports Hub Polska sp. z o.o., while the event partners are MZTS and ROKiS.
- 1.4 The main objectives of the tournament are to determine the TT EUROCUP OPEN Champion in the men's singles category, promote table tennis, encourage physical activity, and foster community integration. The tournament also serves as a promotional platform for the Winners Sports Hub Polska brand and the TT EUROCUP series.

2. PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION

- 2.1 Players aged 16 and above who hold a valid medical certificate confirming their fitness to compete in table tennis (as per Section 12 of the PZTS Regulations) are eligible to participate. All participants compete at their own risk.
 - The tournament is open-entry; however, the number of participants is limited to 48.
- 2.2 The organizers reserve the right to select participants from among those who register.
- 2.3 Registration is available exclusively through the form accessed via a QR code featured on promotional materials. Once the form is completed correctly, the player will receive a registration confirmation. This confirmation does not guarantee acceptance into the tournament.
- 2.4 The final list of participants will be published no later than 48 hours before the start of the tournament. All qualified players will also be contacted by phone.



- 2.5 The registration form must include: full name, date of birth, club affiliation, contact phone number, email address, and current ranking.
- 2.6 No entry fee is required participation in the tournament is entirely free of charge.

3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 3.1 The tournament will be played using a group-stage followed by a knockout format. In the group stage, players will be divided into 16 groups of 3, competing in a round-robin format.
- 3.2 The top two players from each group will advance to the main draw, which will consist of a 32-player single-elimination bracket. A third-place match will also be played.
- 3.3 All matches are played as best-of-five sets. The fifth set is played to 6 points, without deuce; service changes after each point.
- 3.4 Seeding will be based on international, European, or national rankings. However, the organizer reserves the right to adjust the seeding at their own discretion.
 - The tournament will follow the official rules of the International Table Tennis
- 3.5 Federation (ITTF) and PZTS regulations for the 2024/2025 season.
- The tournament will be played on 6 tables. Official equipment includes Butterfly 3.6 Space Saver 25 tables and Tibhar 40+ SynTT NG *** balls.

4. TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The tournament office will be open at the venue throughout the event. All players must confirm their presence and sign the tournament regulations upon arrival.
 - The official opening ceremony will take place at 08:45. Group stage matches will be
- 4.2 played in three rounds starting at 09:00, 10:30, and 12:00. The knockout stage will begin at 13:30.



- 4.3 Quarterfinals will start at 17:00, semifinals at 18:00, and the final and third-place match at 19:00. A lunch break is scheduled from 16:00 to 17:00.
- 4.4 A detailed schedule will be published on the website www.winnershub.net following the close of registration on 17 August 2025.

5. PRIZES

5.1 he total prize pool is 32,000 PLN, distributed as follows:

1st place - 10,000 PLN

2nd place - 8,000 PLN

3rd place - 6,000 PLN

4th place - 4,000 PLN

5th-8th place – 1,000 PLN each

5.2 Attendance at the awards ceremony is mandatory for all prize winners.

ORGANIZATION AND GENERAL RULES

- 6.1 Participants are responsible for arranging their own accommodation and meals. A catering point will be available at the venue.
- 6.2 By signing the tournament regulations, participants agree to the recording and use of their image in photos, videos, and other media for non-commercial purposes by the organizer and its partners. The consent is voluntary, unlimited in time and territory, and may be withdrawn in writing. Withdrawal does not affect any use of content made prior to the withdrawal
- 6.3 The organizer is not liable for injuries, accidents, or property loss during the tournament.
- 6.4 All disputes, complaints, or appeals will be resolved exclusively by the organizer Winners Sports Hub Polska sp. z o.o. Written complaints submitted after the event will be addressed within 14 days.



6.5 By registering, participants consent to the processing of their personal data, including images, by the organizer for the purpose of tournament organization and promotion. Participants retain the right to access, correct, or delete their data in accordance with GDPR.

7. DISCIPLINARY RULES

- 7.1 The organizer has the right to exclude any participant found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 7.2 Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in penalties, including warnings or disqualification.
- 7.3 The following behaviors are strictly prohibited: aggressive or vulgar conduct, smoking (including e-cigarettes) in restricted areas, using mobile phones near playing tables, and excessive noise during matches.

8. FORCE MAJEURE

- 8.1 In case of unforeseen circumstances (e.g. technical failure, external disruption), the organizer reserves the right to postpone or suspend the tournament.
- 8.2 Prize payouts will only be issued if the tournament is completed in full and final standings (1st–8th place) are determined.
